

- > Read all instructions before installing any Havis, Inc. products.
- > Check for obstructions (Wires, brake lines, fuel tank, etc.) before drilling any holes!
 - Use hardware provided with install kit















Carefully remove OEM trim from rear hatch



Temporarily remove ground bolt from driver side of trim panel. (5/16 socket)



Temporarily remove OEM fastener from door lock mounting bracket. (5/16 socket)



Attach mounting brackets to rear window screen and hold up to interior window frame.



Follow same process for window bars.



Line up to previously removed OEM fasteners. Re-install fasteners in slotted holes in bracket and tighten.







Using supplied #10 x 1/2" Tek screws, install in remaining holes in brackets.




Loosely install OEM trim as tight as possible. Mark bracket locations and remove trim. Notch plastic as needed for clearance. Re-install when all trimming complete.




Lower headliner



View of driver upper bracket with screws installed.




Remove all OEM trim from rear section of vehicle.



On side window screens, if OEM "Ready for the road" light pods are not installed, attach filler brackets using supplied 10-32 x 1/2" bolts, washers and nylock nuts.







Side cargo screens shown with light pod filler attached.

Attach upper and lower brackets to guard.

Repeat process for other side.



Mount brackets steel window frame with #10 x 1/2" TEK screws.



Notch plastic as needed and reinstall all trim. Notching headliner not required.


Repeat for other side



Place window screen or bars into window opening. Center window guard between black tint on glass.



Place lower OEM trim up to window guard and mark section to be cut.



Installation is now complete.
